**RENATO DULBECCO
EXCELLENCY AWARD**

Renato Dulbecco (February 22, 1914 – February 19, 2012) was an Italian American, who won the 1975 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for his work on oncoviruses, which are viruses that can cause cancer when they infect animal cells. Born in Italy in 1914, Renato Dulbecco was a virologist who won the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine along with Howard M. Temin and David Baltimore.

EXCELLENCY AWARD**

Kennedy took up the mantle, engaging the cancer community in the effort to craft the 21st Century Cancer ALERT Act. The legislation, introduced in April, 2009 aims to modernize the war on cancer by accelerating the search for cures, more effective treatments and better preventive measures while addressing the ongoing needs of cancer patients.
